



## HIV care continuum for US, Alameda County, Contra Costa County

 Contra Costa County data are from "HIV Surveillance Brief," data to 2014, published Aug 2016.

### UNAIDS | 2016-2021 Strategy




**Alameda County:** 200-300 new diagnoses per year since 2006. At the end of 2015, there were about 5,897 PLWHIV residing in Alameda County.

**Contra Costa County:** 104 new diagnoses in 2014. In December 2014, there were about 2,075 PLWHIV.

**Age disparities:** 20 to 29-year-olds are 2-3 times more likely to be diagnosed with HIV in Alameda (2.3x) and Contra Costa (2.8x) Counties compared to all ages.

**Racial disparities:** African Americans are 4-6 times more likely to be diagnosed with HIV in Alameda (4.5x) and Contra Costa (5.7x) Counties compared to Whites.

# The Collective Impact model



## Goals and metrics from the Oakland TGA Integrated Plan, 2017-2021

### Prevention: by 2021...

1. Reduce the # of new HIV diagnoses by  $\geq 25\%$
2. Increase the % of MSM and TG persons tested by  $\geq 20\%$  (publicly-funded)
3. Increase the # people on PrEP by  $\geq 100\%$
4. Reduce the % of late testers among new HIV diagnoses by  $\geq 50\%$

### Linkage & Retention: by 2021...

1. Increase the % of PLWHA linked to care within 30 days of dx to  $\geq 90\%$
2. Increase the % of PLWHA retained with 1 medical visit/year to  $\geq 90\%$
3. Increase the % of PLWHA who are virally suppressed to  $\geq 80\%$
4. Increase the % of Ryan White clients stably housed to  $\geq 90\%$
